Delegations will find attached a table with information about the state of play concerning the implementation of Council Framework Decision 2003/577/JHA of 22 July 2003 on the execution in the European Union of orders freezing property or evidence (OJ L 196, 2.8.2003, p.45). In accordance with Article 14, the Framework Decision should have been implemented by 2 August 2005.
